Despite repeated directions the demarcation using the Total Station Method has not even commenced what to speak of conclusion of the demarcation. As a final opportunity, we are directing the Government of NCT of Delhi to have the demarcation done before the next date of hearing. We also direct the ASI and Delhi Government to ensure that protected monuments are maintained and not permitted to be demolished by the encrochers and other persons. The entire area covered by the reserved forest is approximately 184 acres. There may be some difficulty as pointed out by the Government of NCT of Delhi with regard to demarcation of the peripheral areas. However, the demarcation in respect of the areas where there is no dispute ought to be done immediately so that the reserved forest can be preserved.
