Mr Anuj Aggarwal, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the  
Government of NCT of Delhi, submits that the demarcation of the entire park area



would be conducted through Total Station Method. The same shall be concluded and a report be submitted to this Court within three weeks. Mr Aggarwal further submits that for fixing time for initiation of the demarcation proceedings, the representatives of the parties shall meet the concerned SDM at 2 pm on 30.09.2016.

The learned counsel for the Delhi Waqf Board submits that she requires some more time to file the affidavit with regard to the action taken in respect of Kala Mahal Masjid as also the photographs which were required to be geo-tagged and numbered so that they can be easily located on a map. The same be done within three weeks.

Mr Pant, the learned counsel appearing for the DDA, submits that the affidavit is ready and the same shall be filed in the course of the day and a copy of the same has been given to Mr Gourab Banerji, who appears for the petitioners.

Mr Pushkarna, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Delhi Jal Board, submits that he shall be filing a status report before the next date of hearing.
