- 1. The present appeal has been preferred by the appellant seeking quashing/setting aside of the impugned judgment dated 18.10.2023 and order on sentence dated 25.11.2023 passed by learned trial Court in case SC No.6933/2016 in FIR No.481/2008, for the offence punishable under Section 302/411/34 IPC & Section 3(1)(i)/3(2)/3(5) of the Maharashtra Control of Organized Crime Act, 1999 as extended to the territories of Delhi whereby appellant was held guilty and has been sentenced to undergo sentence, *inter alia*, imprisonment for life.
- 2. Vide this application, the appellant is seeking suspension of sentence during the pendency of the appeal.

3. The learned APP for State has opposed the present application by submitting that there are serious allegations against the appellant. Thus,

the present application deserves to be dismissed.

4. As per nominal roll dated 07.02.2024, the appellant has undergone

sentence for 14 years 10 months and 8 days and earned remission of 12

days. Thus, as on date, he has undergone around 15 years in

incarceration.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and the fact that the present

appeal is of 2024 and there are old appeals pending before us and the

hearing of present appeal shall take substantial time, we hereby suspend

the sentence of the appellant during the pendency of the appeal.

Consequently, the appellant be released on bail, if not required in any

other case, on his furnishing a bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with one surety of

like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court concerned.

6. Copy of order be transmitted to the learned trial Court and to the

concerned jail authorities for compliance.

7. Application stands disposed of.
