- 1. The present Writ Petition has been filed for a direction to the Respondents to produce the reasons for blocking the open-source messaging application of the Petitioner called '*Briar*'.
- 2. It is stated that by a report dated 15.02.2023, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology has blocked 14 mobile apps including the Petitioner's App.
- 3. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner relies on Section 69A (1) & (2) of the Information Technology Act 2000, to contend that any order of blocking any resource on internet must be supported by reasons.
